### **Introducing Two New Training Classes!**

We are proud to offer two new classes! CDL Class A training prepares students to earn a Commercial Driver's License (CDL), Class A, enabling them to drive both class A and B commercial vehicles with airbrakes. The program includes classroom instruction, focused on preparing participants for the written exam, yard training, truck inspection, on-site driving and supervised over-the-road driving.

We also offer a Small Engine Repair class designed to teach students how to repair and maintain a variety of small engines commonly found in outdoor power equipment. This course provides a foundation for individuals interested in pursuing a career in small engine repair or those looking to maintain their own equipment. Our state - certified driver's education class includes 30 hours of classroom instruction along with the required 14 hours of in-the-car driving instruction and observation. This is our 17<sup>th</sup> year offering classes in New Castle County. A deposit is required when registering. You must call the contact below or register on- line to reserve your seat.

### **Driving WILL extend beyond these dates**

<u>Tuition reimbursement</u> - 9<sup>th</sup> grade private and public school students going into the 10<sup>th</sup> grade not <u>longer</u> qualify for reimbursement from the Department of Education (DOE). However, you may take the class for the full tuition amount of \$648.

<u>Home school students</u>- Students in the  $10^{th}$ ,  $11^{th}$ , or  $12^{th}$  grade will qualify for DOE funding in the amount of \$648 toward your tuition one time. The cost to students will be \$45 due at registration.

Public/ Private school students. For students who are 15 ½ years old or more and would like to take driver education this summer, the cost for is \$648. This is applicable for public/private schools. where a driver ed teacher is provided during the school year. \$126 deposit is required to secure set in the class. Remaining balance must be paid in full before Blue Slip can be issued. Form of payments accepted - Credit Card, Check or Money Orders.


