



New Dual Enrollment Option for High School Students

The Sussex Tech Adult Education Introduction to Marine Service Technology course prepares students to earn a Yamaha Service Technician Certificate. The certificate is the first step in becoming a certified Yamaha outboard technician. The 48 hour course is offered after school, allowing participants to attend high school and utilize the activity bus for transportation. The program includes



classroom instruction, and hands-on labs. Each participant will have an opportunity to pass the Yamaha Outboard Technician exam and earn the first credential on the master technician career path outlined by Yamaha Marine University. 


